NOXIOUS/INVASIVE TREE SPECIES LIST

The following tree species may be considered as noxious, invasive exotic or undesirable in sensitive plant communities. Their removal may be warranted for ecological restoration purposes. Removals of these species should not require mitigation, as set forth in Section 612.
