

ORDINANCE NO. 100-2002

HONEY BROOK TOWNSHIP
CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HONEY BROOK, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE HONEY BROOK TOWNSHIP ZONING ORDINANCE OF 1979, AS PREVIOUSLY AMENDED, BY REVISING AND AMENDING ARTICLE VII, SECTION 704.3, FLOOD HAZARD DISTRICT, OF SAID ORDINANCE.

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED, and it is enacted and ordained by authority of the Board of Supervisors of Honey Brook Township that the Township Zoning Ordinance of 1979, as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:

- I. Article VII, Section 704.3, is hereby amended to read, "Floodplain/Flood Hazard Districts shall also be deemed to include the following three types of flood district which shall be determined, in part, from the Flood Boundary and Floodway Map prepared by the Federal Insurance Administration, Federal Emergency Management Agency dated August 1, 1984, or the most recent edition thereof, in which the following districts are recognized:"
- II. Article VII, Section 704.3.a), Section 704.3.b), and Section 704.3.c) shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE FIVE (5) DAYS AFTER ENACTMENT AS PROVIDED BY LAW.
