

**ORDINANCE NO. 101-2002**  
**HONEY BROOK TOWNSHIP**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HONEY BROOK, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE HONEY BROOK TOWNSHIP SUBDIVISION AND LAND DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE OF 1995, AS AMENDED, BY AMENDING ARTICLE II AND ARTICLE VI TO REQUIRE ON-LOT STORMWATER MANAGEMENT FACILITIES TO COMPLY WITH CERTAIN DESIGN CHARACTERISTICS.

- I. Article VI, Section 627.D.6 is hereby amended by adding a new subparagraph "a," and re-lettering subsequent paragraphs sequentially as follows:

"a. Erosion and sedimentation control and stormwater management control facilities for subdivisions containing two or more lots shall utilize a common stormwater management detention facility, except the Township, upon recommendation by the Township Engineer, may authorize individual, on-lot stormwater management detention facilities which comply with subsection 627.I."


- II. Article II, Section 202 is hereby amended by adding the following definitions:

STORMWATER MANAGEMENT DETENTION FACILITY(S)—Those facilities, including but not limited to detention/retention basins, detention/retention berms, infiltration/recharge pits and/or trenches, designed to regulate and control stormwater runoff rate, erosion and sedimentation.


Provisions of this ordinance shall take effect as provided for by law.

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED this 10<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2002.


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
