ORDINANCE NO. 112 - 2004

**AN ORDINANCE ADOPTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 3363 OF THE PENNSYLVANIA VEHICLE CODE, 75 Pa, C.S.A 3363, ALTERING MAXIMUM SPEED LIMITS ON LAMMEY ROAD (T-333) AND GRIESON ROAD (T-339) IN HONEY BROOK TOWNSHIP.**

**BE IT HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED** by the authority of the Board of Supervisors of the Honey Brook Township, in accordance with the authority granted to the Township by section 3363 of the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code, 75 Pa.C.S.A. 3363, as follows:

1. In accordance with the "Speed Restrictions Study and Data Sheets" prepared by Richard J. Craig, P.E., and submitted to the Township on or about April 24, 2004, the Board does hereby find:

- a. The Study submitted to the Township constitutes an "engineering and traffic investigation" as required by section 3363.
- b. Pursuant to such investigation, the Board determines that the maximum speed permitted by the Vehicle Code is greater than is reasonable and safe under the conditions found to exist on LammeY Road from it's intersection with Beaver Dam Road to the Township Line.
- c. The Board establishes a reasonable and safe limit of 35 miles per hour on the aforesaid section of LammeY Road.


2. In accordance with the "Speed Restrictions Study and Data Sheets" prepared by Richard J. Craig, P.E., and submitted to the Township on or about May 29, 2004, the Board does hereby find:


- a. Grieson Road meets the requirement of being a residential area as described by Title, 75 Section 102.
- b. Pursuant to such investigation, the Board determines that the maximum speed permitted by the Vehicle Code is greater than is reasonable and safe under the conditions found to exist on Grieson Road from it's intersection with Chestnut Tree Road and Cupola Road.
- c. The Board establishes a reasonable and safe limit of 25 miles per hour on the aforesaid section of Grieson Road




