

**ORDINANCE NO. 118-2006
HONEY BROOK TOWNSHIP
CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA**


AN ORDINANCE PURSUANT TO SECTION 1507 OF THE 2ND CLASS TOWNSHIP CODE AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP TO ENTER INTO INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATION AGREEMENTS WITH THE FOLLOWING MUNICIPALITIES: ATGLEN BOROUGH, CALN TOWNSHIP, CITY OF COATESVILLE, EAST BRANDYWINE TOWNSHIP, EAST CALN TOWNSHIP, MODENA BOROUGH, PARKESBURG BOROUGH, SOUTH COATESVILLE BOROUGH, UPPER UWCHLAN TOWNSHIP, WEST BRADFORD TOWNSHIP, WEST BRANDYWINE TOWNSHIP, WEST GROVE BOROUGH AND WEST PIKELAND TOWNSHIP, ALL OF WHICH ARE LOCATED IN CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF PERFORMING GOVERNMENTAL POWERS, DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS AS ALLOWED BY LAW AND DEEMED NECESSARY AND BENEFICIAL BY THE MUNICIPALITY.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Honey Brook Township as follows:


1. The Township authorizes the proper officers of the Township to enter into an Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement with the aforementioned municipalities.
2. The aforesaid agreement shall continue until revoked by action by each respective municipality participating in said agreement.
3. The purpose and objectives of the agreement is to facilitate proposals, agreements, cooperative actions and to promote the health, safety and welfare of the participating municipalities with the least expenditure on behalf of the participating municipalities.
4. The agreement shall be financed by the use of proper funds of the participating municipalities as permitted by statute.
5. Each municipality shall designate a representative to implement the agreement.
6. If any provision, sentence, clause, phrase, section or part of this Ordinance is found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, phrases or parts of the Ordinance.
7. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances conflicting or inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
8. This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days from the date hereof.


