ORDINANCE NO. 23, 1999

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE POLICE SERVICE CONTRACT BETWEEN HONEY BROOK TOWNSHIP AND HONEY BROOK BOROUGH.

The Board of Supervisors of Honey Brook Township and the Borough Council of Honey Brook Borough have previously entered into a Police Service Contract. That Contract was approved by Ordinance adopted in 1991.

The Borough and the Township have agreed to new provisions regarding the Contract and have prepared a new Contract, with the anticipation that a new intergovernmental cooperation agreement will be executed for 1999, and subsequent years.

In connection therewith, an agreement has been drafted outlining the functions, powers and responsibilities in connection with this intergovernmental agreement, and outlining charges to be paid by the Borough to the Township, and the maximum amounts thereof.

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED and it hereby is enacted and ordained by the authority of the Board of Supervisors of Honey Brook Township that an agreement attached as Exhibit "A" to this Ordinance is hereby adopted. The term of the agreement is one (1) year, which terminates automatically, unless both the Borough and the Township give notice to one another regarding the extension thereof, as set forth therein. The purpose and objectives of the agreement provide for the Police Department of the Township of Honey Brook to provide police services to the residents and citizens of the Borough of Honey Brook. The initial annual charge to the Borough of Honey Brook shall be \$50,000.00 per annum, payable quarterly in advance. Subsequent years may be adjusted as set forth in the contract.
