

HONEY BROOK TOWNSHIP
Resolution 13-2002
Township Position on Host Municipal Fees

Whereas, the Board of Supervisors of Honey Brook Township desires to support those municipalities who have solid waste landfills within their municipal boundaries, hereinafter known as Host Municipalities; and

Whereas, the General Assembly imposed a fee of \$1.00 per ton of solid waste as a benefit to Host Municipalities to offset the harmful effects of hosting a waste landfill; and

Whereas, the Host Municipal fee has not been increased since its inception in 1988; and

Whereas, Honey Brook Township—as a Host Municipality—enjoys a superior neighborly relationship with the landfill owned and operated by the Chester County Solid Waste Authority (CCSWA); and


Whereas, the CCSWA voluntarily contributes more than the legislated minimum to its Host Municipalities and also contributes to vital community organizations; and


Whereas, not every Host Municipality enjoys such a close relationship with the landfill it hosts;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of Honey Brook Township, to urge the Legislature to increase the Host Municipal fee imposed on solid waste landfills during its next legislative session.


