Resolution 2-2003

A Resolution to participate in the PA Capital City Automotive and Equipment Contract

WHEREAS, Section 1902 of Act 57 of May 15, 1998, (Title 62 Pa. C.S. 1902), known as the "Commonwealth Procurement Code", permits local public procurement units, local municipalities, and authorities to sponsor, establish, participate in, conduct, or administer a cooperative purchasing agreement for the procurement of any goods, materials, equipment, or services with another local procurement unit. A local procurement unit is defined as: any political subdivision, public authority, educational, health, or other institution; and to the extent provided by law, any other entity, including a council of governments or an area government; nonprofit fire, rescue or ambulance company; and any nonprofit cooperation operating a charitable hospital; and

WHEREAS, it is hereby deemed to be in the best interest of the Township to participate in the PA Capital City (PACC) Automotive and Equipment Contract, which is administered by the City of Harrisburg.

NOW, BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, THAT the Board of Supervisors of Honey Brook Township, that the Township shall participate in the PACC Automotive and Equipment Contract, by purchasing, from time to time, supplies and services from the contract based upon the terms and conditions of the contract and at the prices quoted as part of the contract. Further, the Township shall be responsible for the payment of all contracted supplies or services initiated by the Township directly to the provider of the contracted supplies or service for expenses directly related.
