RESOLUTION 2-2007
HONEY BROOK TOWNSHIP



WHEREAS, the Township of Honey Brook (the "Township") has previously created an Agricultural Security Area as authorized under Act 43 (the "Act") of the Statutes of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and

WHEREAS, the Township receives applications from interested landowners to add to or modify the Agricultural Security Area between statutory review periods by including their properties, and

WHEREAS, the Township has received applications on the dates specified to modify the Agricultural Security Area by adding the following properties:

- ~~Levi S. King & Ruth Ann King, 295 Pequea Ave, TPN 12-1-19 & 12-1-18, on March 30, 2006~~
- Christian S. Fisher and Barbara F. Fisher, 2050 Cambridge Road, TPN 22-7-83 on December 19, 2006

WHEREAS, the Township has taken no official action on the application of Levi King prior to expiration of the one-hundred eighty (180) day review period, and

WHEREAS, the Township held a public hearing on February 14, 2007 on the application of Christian Fisher,

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED the Board of Supervisors of Honey Brook Township deems these properties to be included in the Honey Brook Township Agricultural Security Area as required under the Act, and directs the Township Secretary to take appropriate action to record the inclusion of these properties with the Recorder of Deeds.

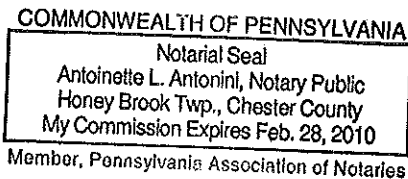

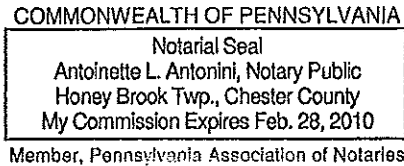
