

HONEY BROOK TOWNSHIP
Resolution 2-2009
Honey Brook Borough Road Salt

WHEREAS, Honey Brook Borough has asked to collaborate with the Township in the purchase of road salt during the 2009-10 winter plowing season; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough's expected usage is 25 tons for a typical winter; and

WHEREAS, the Township purchases its road salt through the Commonwealth's COSTARS contracting program; and

WHEREAS, the COSTARS program has defined minimum and maximum purchase limit, and

WHEREAS, the Township has sufficient storage and reserve capacity to help a neighbor,

NOW, BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, the Board of Supervisors of Honey Brook Township agrees to furnish Honey Brook Borough its road salt for the 2009-10 plowing season under the following parameters:

1. The Boro shall haul salt from the Township's storage facility on Suplee Road utilizing its own trucks.
2. The Boro shall submit before and after weight tickets to verify the amount hauled.
3. The Township will assist with loading.
4. The Township shall submit an invoice for salt (at the Township's COSTARS price) based on the weight tickets, to be paid promptly by the Boro.
5. The total amount to be supplied to the Boro shall be not greater than 50 tons through April 15, 2009.
