Recording Devices

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISOR, HONEY BROOK TOWNSHIP, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA TO ADOPT CERTAIN RULES CONCERNING USE OF RECORDING DEVICES AT PUBLIC MEETINGS.

WHEREAS, the Sunshine Act 65 P>S> 271, et. seq. permits those persons attending public meetings to record the proceedings with recording devices; and

WHEREAS, the said Act permits the promulgation of reasonable rules governing said use;

BE IT RESOLVED, therefore that all persons attending a public meeting who desire to use a recording device during any portion of said public meeting shall comply with the following:



- 1) Identify themselves to the public body;
- 2) Identify the type of recording device being utilized, ie. videotape, audiotape, etc.;
- 3) No person utilizing a recording device shall do so in a manner causing or intending to cause disruption of said proceedings'
- 4) In no way shall any recording be done without such person first alerting the public body prior to commencement of the meeting that a recording device will be in use.
- 5) Recording device must be set up prior to commencement of the meeting so as not to cause disruption of said proceedings'
