RESOLUTION 8-2010

WHEREAS, the Township of Honey Brook (the "Township") has previously created an Agricultural Security Area as authorized under Act 43 (the "Act") of the Statutes of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and

WHEREAS, the Township receives application(s) from interested landowners to add to or modify the Agricultural Security Area between statutory review periods by including their property(s), and

WHEREAS, the Act deems a property included the Agricultural Security Area one-hundred eighty (180) days from the date of the application, unless the Township takes official action prior to the end of the review period, and

WHEREAS, the Township has received application(s) on the date(s) specified to modify the Agricultural Security Area by adding the following property(s):

- Marlin & Wanda King, 70 King Road (TPN 22-9-27 & 22-9-21.3), totaling 97 acres more or less, on January 3, 2010

WHEREAS, the Township has taken no official action on these application(s) prior to expiration of the one-hundred eighty (180) day review period,


