**RESOLUTION #9-2010**

**WHEREAS**, Section 5 of the Act of January 24, 1966, P.L. 1535, No. 537, known as the "Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act," as amended, and the Rules and Regulations of the Department of Environmental Protection (hereinafter, the "Department") adopted thereunder, Chapter 71 of Title 25 of the **Pennsylvania Code**, requires the municipality to adopt an Official Sewage Facilities Plan providing for sewage services adequate to prevent contamination of waters and/or environmental health hazards with sewage wastes, and to revise said plan whenever it is necessary to meet the sewage disposal needs of the municipality, and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Honey Brook, (hereinafter, the "Board of Supervisors") authorized the preparation of an official Sewage Facilities Plan (hereinafter, the "Plan") for the Township; and

**WHEREAS**, Herbert, Rowland & Grubic Inc. was selected as the consultant to assist the Board of Supervisors in the preparation of the Plan which addresses the wastewater disposal needs of the Township; and

The alternatives of choice to be implemented are the revision of the existing public sewer service area boundaries to bring sewage facilities planning in-line with recent Township planning efforts, the implementation of a township-wide Sewage Facilities Management Plan to further decrease the percentage of malfunctions and improve the quality of private wells, and the eventual provision of increased wastewater treatment capacity at the Northwestern Chester County Municipal Authority's (hereinafter, the "NCCMA") Wastewater Treatment Plant. The key implementation activities/dates include: revise sewer service area boundaries and develop and implement the Sewage Facilities Management Plan 0-1 year from date of Plan approval, NCCMA study to determine the most cost effective and beneficial alternative to increase wastewater treatment capacity 0-3 years from the date of Plan approval, perform design and obtain all permits, clearances and agreements necessary for construction of the selected upgrade alternative 3-5 years from the date of Plan approval, construct selected upgrade 7-8 years from the date of Plan approval.

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors finds that the Plan described above conforms to applicable zoning, subdivision, other municipal ordinances and plans and to a comprehensive program of pollution control and water management; and

**WHEREAS**, The Board of Supervisors desires to adopt the proposed Sewage Facilities Plan as the Township's official Sewage Facilities Plan in accordance with the provisions and requirements of the Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act and the Regulations of the Department.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE** Board Supervisors of Honey Brook Township, Chester County, Pennsylvania, as follows:


Section 1. The Board of Supervisors hereby adopt and submit to the Department for its approval the sewage facilities plan entitled "ACT 537 Sewage Facilities Plan for Honey Brook Township", prepared by Herbert, Rowland & Grubic Inc. in the form and content presented at this public meeting, as the "Official Plan" for the Township. The municipality hereby assures the Department of the complete and timely implementation of the said plan as required by law. (Section 5, Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act as amended).


Section 2. This Resolution shall become effective and be in force immediately.
