Ordinance No. 170

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HONEY BROOK AMENDING THE HONEY BROOK TOWNSHIP PERMANENT STORMWATER MANAGEMENT CONTROLS ORDINANCE [CHAPTER 20], AS AMENDED, IN ITS ENTIRETY TO MEET PADEP REQUIREMENTS TO ADOPT A STORMWATER MANAGEMENT ORDINANCE CONSISTENT WITH THE "COUNTY-WIDE ACT 167 STORMWATER MANAGEMENT PLAN ADDENDUM TO WATERSHEDS, AN INTEGRATED WATER RESOURCES PLAN FOR CHESTER COUNTY, PA AND ITS WATERSHEDS" ("PLAN") ADOPTED BY THE CHESTER COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY PADEP.

SECTION 1. Delete Chapter 20, Permanent Stormwater Management Controls, in its entirety, and replace it with the following "Honey Brook Township Stormwater Management Ordinance".

<u>SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY</u>. If any sentence, clause, section or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts hereof. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Board of Supervisors of Honey Brook Township that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.

SECTION 3. REPEALER. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances conflicting with any provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this Ordinance.
