

ORDINANCE # 56 - 1994

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HONEY BROOK BEING AN
AMENDMENT TO THE HONEY BROOK TOWNSHIP ZONING
ORDINANCE OF 1979 AS AMENDED TO ADD REGULATIONS DEALING
WITH SWIMMING POOLS**

Section 901.1B is hereby amended by adding a subparagraph 4 as follows:

Section 901.1B(4) SWIMMING POOLS - private non-commercial swimming pools designed to contain a water depth of 24 inches or more shall be located only in rear yards or side yards. No permanent pool as defined above shall be permitted without an operable filtration system including the utilization of chlorine, bromine or other acceptable anti-bacterial agent. All swimming pools shall be completely enclosed by a permanent four foot high childproof fence or wall which shall encircle the pool area and shall be constructed with a self-closing and self-latching gate; however, this requirement for such fencing shall not apply to above-ground pools having a vertical wall height of four feet and having a retractable ladder or other means of preventing entry to the pool. When required, the aforesaid fence or wall shall be erected before any pool is filled with water. All pools must be set back at least ten feet from all rear or side yards or permanent easements. No water from a pool shall be discharged onto any public street or alley. These requirements shall not apply to manmade lakes, ponds or other impoundments unless the primary purpose for the construction thereof is swimming.
