

ORDINANCE NO. 57 1994

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE HONEY BROOK TOWNSHIP ZONING
ORDINANCE OF 1979 (ORDINANCE NO. 28) BY ELIMINATING THE
PROVISIONS REQUIRING FULL-TIME ATTENDANTS AT GASOLINE
SERVICE STATIONS WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP

BE IT ENACTED AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED by the Board of
Supervisors of Honey Brook Township that Sections 202 and 901.14 are hereby amended by
deleting the last sentence of each of said Sections as referencing gasoline service stations so
that the last sentence of each of said Sections shall hereafter read: "A permitted self-service
gasoline station must have adequate fire extinguishers at the pumps and ample 'NO
SMOKING' signs posted".

This Amendment shall take effect as provided for by law.

All Ordinance provisions inconsistent with this Amendment are hereby repealed
and deleted.
