

ORDINANCE NO. 73 - 1996

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HONEY BROOK, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE HONEY BROOK TOWNSHIP ZONING ORDINANCE OF 1979, AS AMENDED, BY DELETING CERTAIN LANGUAGE OF SECTION 1004.

IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED by authority of the Board of Supervisors of Honey Brook Township, Chester County, Pennsylvania that the Honey Brook Township Zoning Ordinance of 1979, as amended, is further amended by deleting the following paragraph from Section 1004:

" A certificate of nonconformity issued by the Zoning Officer will be considered sufficient proof of said nonconformity. Certificate of nonconformity will be issued on application within ninety (90) days of the effective date of this Ordinance. After the 90-day period, certificate of nonconformity will be issued by the Board of Supervisors upon consideration of proof submitted by the applicant."
