## **ORDINANCE NO.** <u>75</u> - 1997

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HONEY BROOK, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE HONEY BROOK TOWNSHIP ZONING ORDINANCE OF 1979, AS AMENDED, BY DELETING SECTION 1103, TIME LIMITATIONS FOR PERMITS.

IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED by authority of the Board of Supervisors of Honey Brook Township, Chester County, Pennsylvania that the Honey Brook Township Zoning Ordinance of 1979, as amended, is further amended by deleting the following Section 1103.1:

Every permit issued shall be good only for the period of six months from its date, unless if it is exercised or used within the period of six months and unless once commenced it is continually exercised or used. If work ceases for a period of six months, unless such cessation is for justifiable cause, the permit shall expire.
