

ORDINANCE NO. 76 - 1997

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HONEY BROOK RESTRICTING
BRANDAMORE ROAD TO RESTRICTED 35M.P.H. SPEED ZONE**

BE IT ENACTED AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of Honey Brook Township that the following roadway is restricted to a speed zone.

SECTION 1. As a result of traffic engineering studies, the Board of Supervisors believing the public safety concerns require the restriction of speed on certain roadways hereby declares that Brandamore Road from Birdell Road easterly 0.9 of one mile to the West Brandywine Township line shall hereafter be restricted to a maximum speed limit of 35 m.p.h.

SECTION 2. The Township personnel shall comply with all provisions of the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code to appropriately sign said roadway as required by the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

SECTION 3. Any person violating the aforesaid restricted speed limit shall be subject to violation and fines and costs in accordance with the provisions of the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code, as amended from time to time.

SECTION 4. All Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect five (5) days from the date of adoption.
