ORDINANCE NO. 98-78

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HONEY BROOK IN ORDER TO VACATE CERTAIN ROADS WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP PURSUANT TO THE PENNSYLVANIA SECOND CLASS TOWNSHIP CODE, ACT NO. 1995-60, 53 P.S. §67304.

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of Honey Brook Township, County of Chester, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, as follows:

The following Township roads are hereby vacated:

- T337 September Road from the intersection of Park Road for a distance of 4,700 feet.
- T348 Lombard Street from the intersection of North Street 354 feet north to the intersection of Meadville Road.
- T471 Mill Road from the intersection of Cambridge Road south for a distance of 736 feet.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
