ORDINANCE NO. 82, 1998

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTED PURSUANT TO THE PENNSYLVANIA VEHICLE CODE, 75 Pa.C.S.A. §6109, DESIGNATING MEADVILLE ROAD AS A THROUGH HIGHWAY AND MILL ROAD AS A STOP INTERSECTION IN HONEY BROOK TOWNSHIP.

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the authority of the Board of Supervisors of Honey Brook Township, in accordance with the authority granted to the Township by Section 6109 of the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code, 75 Pa.C.S.A. §6109, as follows:

1. After an appropriate engineering and traffic investigation, conducted by the Township road crew, and reviewed by the Township Police Department, the Board of Supervisors determines that Meadville Road, also known as T475, should be a through road at the intersection of Meadville Road and Mill Road.

2. Mill Road northbound at the intersection of Meadville Road is hereby designated as a stop intersection.

3. Any ordinance making another "stop" or "through" or other "stop" or "through" designations at the same intersection is repealed.
