

## RESOLUTION FOR ACT 537 PLAN UPDATE REVISION

9-1995

### RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF HONEY BROOK TOWNSHIP, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

WHEREAS, Section 5 of the Act of January 24, 1966, P.L. 1535, No. 537, known as the "Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act," as amended, and the Rules and Regulations of the Department of Environmental Protection (Department) adopted thereunder, Chapter 71 of Title 25 of the Pennsylvania Code, requires the municipality to adopt an Official Sewage Facilities Plan providing for sewage services adequate to prevent contamination of waters and/or environmental health hazards with sewage wastes, and to revise said plan whenever it is necessary to meet the sewage disposal needs of the municipality, and

WHEREAS, Honey Brook Township has prepared an Act 537 Plan Update which provides for sewage facilities in portions of Honey Brook Township, and

WHEREAS, Honey Brook Township finds that the plan described above conforms to applicable zoning, subdivision, other municipal ordinances and plans and to a comprehensive program of pollution control and water quality management.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Supervisors of Honey Brook Township hereby adopt and submit to the Department of Environmental Protection for its approval as a revision to the "Official Plan" of the municipality, the above-referenced Plan. The municipality hereby assures the Department of the complete and timely implementation of the said plan as required by law. (Section 5, Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act as amended).

The alternatives of choice to be implemented include:

- A. Adoption and implementation of an Individual Onlot Sewage Management Program Ordinance for Honey Brook Township which will be applied only within the Village of Suplee during the period 1996-1999.
- B. The Plan recommends the creation of three separate sewer districts within the Township including: 1) The West Sewer District; 2) The Cupola Road/Route 322 East Sewer District; and 3) The Village of Suplee Sewer District (created primarily for application of the Individual Onlot Sewage Management Program during the five years ending in 1999).

- C. The Plan recommends various sewage disposal alternatives for each District noted above and recommends similar alternatives for proposed non-sewered areas known as the Agricultural/Rural Residence Wastewater Planning District.
- D. The Plan recommends implementation of the alternatives identified above and the institutional selections noted in the Plan Summary.
