Minutes

New Business

Camps

Tennis Camp-Lee Heller runs - It starts June 24th and runs for 7 weeks the limit is 20 per session.

Kickball Camp-Deb Oldham runs-It Starts June 25 and runs for 7 weeks. The limit is 40 children.

She will need forms with rules, registration form, photo policy, allergies, emergency contact, insurance form-Deb will email Mere form that she uses at Honey Brook Elementary Center.

She will be able to store supplies either at the township building or at the maintenance building and she will need a first aid kit. What happens if weather is iffy or stormy-There is the pavilion but Mere needs to check it out and there needs to be contacts for parents.

Park Rules

Rules were reviewed again regarding dogs. Lee Heller and Joe Fenstermacher thought that bags should be put up for dogs on a trial basis. Joe F. will check into bags for the park. A motion was made regarding dogs in the park. Lee made the motion and Deb seconded all approved.
