

ORDINANCE # 22 - 1976

ORDINANCE to prohibit trucks, except for local deliveries on certain Township roads.

The Board of Supervisors of Honey Brook Township hereby ordains that the following Township roads designated by their popular name as well as by their official Township designation shall hereafter be designated by appropriate signs to prohibit the travel of any trucks, except for local deliveries.

Said Township roads which are to be restricted are as follows: Todd Road being T499 between State Route #10 and State Route #322; Poplar Road being T501 between State Route #10 and Route #322; Reservoir Road being T545 and T505 between State Route #10 and Route #322.

Any person, partnership, or corporation who or which shall violate the provisions of this Ordinance by operating or causing to be operated any truck on the above designated roads, except for local deliveries shall be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$300.00. In default of payment of the fine, such persons, the members of such partnership or the officers of such corporation shall be liable to imprisonment for not more than thirty (30) days. All fines collected for the violation of this Ordinance shall be paid over to the municipality namely Honey Brook Township.
