ORDINANCE NO. 30, 1985

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HONEY BROOK, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA REPEALING CERTAIN OUTDATED ORDINANCES AND/OR RESOLUTIONS WHICH MAY BE IN CONFLICT WITH OTHER VALID ORDINANCES AND/OR RESOLUTIONS AND/OR OTHER ENACTMENTS OF THE TOWNSHIP.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Honey Brook, Chester County, Pennsylvania has determined that certain Ordinances, Resolutions and other enactments are outdated or are possibly in conflict with other such Ordinances, Resolutions or other enactments, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Honey Brook, Chester County, Pennsylvania to repeal said outdated or conflicting Ordinances, Resolutions or other enactments.

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED, and it is enacted and ordained by authority of the Board of Supervisors of Honey Brook Township, Chester County, Pennsylvania that the following specifically enumerated Ordinances and Resolutions are repealed:
