

ORDINANCE NO. 41

HONEY BROOK TOWNSHIP

AMENDMENT TO THE HONEY BROOK TOWNSHIP  
ZONING ORDINANCE OF 1979, AS AMENDED

The Honey Brook Township, Chester County, Board of Supervisors, under the authority of the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code, does hereby enact and ordain the following amendment to the Honey Brook Township Zoning Ordinance of 1979, as heretofore amended:

Section 1. Section 200 "Definitions" is hereby amended to include the following:

MUNICIPAL USE. Any use of a lot by Honey Brook Township or by a municipal authority duly formed or incorporated by Honey Brook Township.

Section 2: This amendment shall be effective according to law.
