ORDINANCE NO. 91- 48

AN ORDINANCE OF HONEY BROOK TOWNSHIP, CHESTER COUNTY, AUTHORIZING THE ENTERING OF AN INTER-MUNICIPAL AGREEMENT WITH CHESTER COUNTY SOLID WASTE AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE COLLECTION, PROCESSING AND MARKETING SERVICES FOR RECYCLABLE MATERIALS GENERATED BY MUNICIPAL RECYCLING PROGRAMS

Be it hereby enacted and ordained by the Board of Supervisors of Honey Brook Township, Chester County as follows:

Section 1. The Township is hereby authorized to enter into an Inter-Municipal Agreement between the Chester County Solid Waste Authority and the Township to provide collection, processing and marketing services for recyclable materials generated by municipal recycling programs. The conditions of said Agreement are specifically set forth in a copy of the Agreement which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" hereof and incorporated herein.

Section 2. The duration of the term of the Agreement is twenty-six (26) weeks with an additional renewal period of twenty-six (26) weeks.

Section 3. The purpose of the Agreement is to establish the Honey Brook recycling drop-off center by and through an Agreement between the Chester County Solid Waste Authority and a private contractor.

Section 4. The cost for the collection services during the term of the Agreement shall be paid by the Chester County Solid Waste Authority in the name of the Township.

Section 5. The drop-off center shall be under the sole management and control of the Township.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall be effective five (5) days from the date of enactment.
