ORDINANCE

THIS ORDINANCE made and adopted by the Board of Supervisors of Honey Brook Township.

PREAMBLE: The Board of Supervisors of Honey Brook Township and the Borough Council of Honey Brook Borough are contemplating entering into an intergovernmental cooperation agreement whereby the Police Department of the Township of Honey Brook would provide police services to the citizens of the Borough of Honey Brook. In connection therewith, an agreement has been drafted outlining the functions, powers, and responsibilities in connection with this intergovernmental agreement; outlining charges to be paid by the Borough to the Township and the transfer of certain equipment and files.

Pursuant to the provisions of the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, the Board does hereby enact and ordain as follows:

BE IT ENACTED and it is hereby enacted by the Board of Supervisors of Honey Brook Township that an agreement attached as Exhibit "A" to this Ordinance is hereby adopted. The term of the agreement is one year, renewable year by year automatically unless either the Borough or the Township give notice to one another not to continue with the agreement, which notice must be given one year in advance. The purpose and objectives of the

agreement provide for the Police Department of the Township of Honey Brook to provide police services to the residents and citizens of the Borough of Honey Brook. The initial annual charge to the Borough of Honey Brook shall be Thirty-five Thousand (\$35,000.00) Dollars per annum payable quarterly in advance and adjusted year by year per the mutual agreement of the parties. In connection with the phasing out of the Borough of Honey Brook Police Department, the Township of Honey Brook shall acquire the Borough police car.
