

## ORDINANCE 7-1

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Supervisors of Honey Brook Township, Chester County, Pennsylvania, intends to amend Ordinance No. 7, regulating junk dealers, the establishment and maintenance of junkyards, and proposes to enact at its next regular meeting, June 2, 1966, the following changes.

Section 2, Subdivision E, dealing with definitions shall be amended as follows:

E. JUNK. Shall mean articles that have outlived their usefulness in their original form and are commonly gathered up and sold to be converted into another product, either of the same or a different kind of manufacturing process. It shall include, but not be limited to, scrapped metal, abandoned or junked motor vehicles, machinery, equipment, paper, glass, containers, and structures. It shall not include, however, refuse or garbage kept in a proper container for the purpose of prompt disposal.

Section 2, Subdivision F, shall be amended as follows:

F. JUNK DEALER. Shall mean any person, as heretofore defined, who shall engage in the storage, sale, buying, salvaging, dealing or who shall allow junk, as heretofore defined, to accumulate.
