

Ordinance 9-1 of 1968

AMENDMENT TO TOWNSHIP ZONING ORDINANCE AND MAP

The Board of Supervisors hereby enacts the following amendment to the Township Zoning Map.

"I" industrial district of the Honey Brook Township Zoning Ordinance and Map shall be enlarged and extended to include all that certain tract of land owned by John M. Frankhouser and containing approximately 79 acres, be the same more or less and bounded on the south by the Penn Central Railroad, on the west by Poplar Street, on the north by Raymond Keiffer, et ux, David Brown, et ux and David E. Stoltzfus, et ux; and on the east by David E. Stoltzfus, et ux, and Guymar, Inc.

All provisions and regulations of the Zoning Ordinance shall apply with full force and effect to the area hereby changed."

Approved by the Board of Supervisors of Honey Brook Township and enacted and ordained into an Ordinance this 16 day of May, 1968.
