

Ordinance 9-2 of 1968

AMENDMENT TO TOWNSHIP ZONING ORDINANCE AND MAP

Article V, Section 500. USE REGULATIONS. Is amended to read as follows:

Section 500. USE REGULATIONS. A building may be erected or used, and a lot may be used or occupied, for any of the following purposes and no other:

- B. Retail establishment for sale of dry goods, drugs, food, jewelry, variety and general merchandise, hardware, household furnishings and supplies, instruments, electronic appliances including repair service, job printing, and laundramats, for the purpose of washing clothes and/or dry cleaning.

Section 500, A through H inclusive shall remain in full force and effect and all other sections of Article V shall continue in effect.

Approved by the Board of Supervisors of Honey Brook Township and enacted and ordained into an Ordinance this 16 day of May, 1968.
