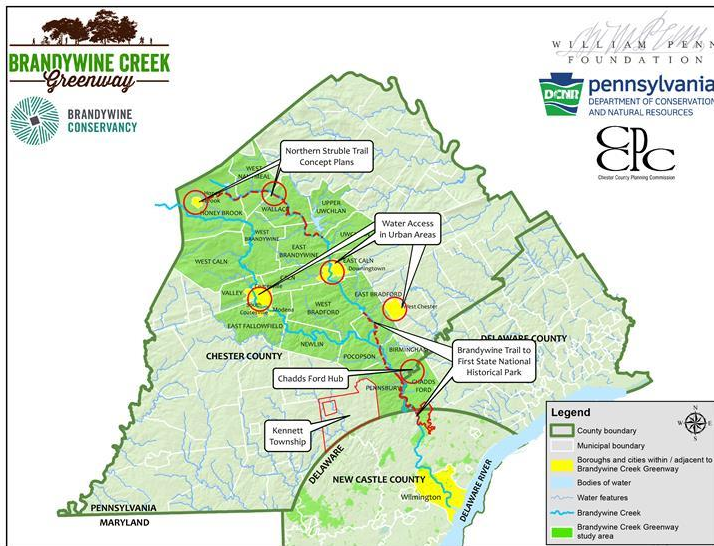

The Brandywine Conservancy has received a generous grant from the William Penn Foundation that will fund several key Brandywine Creek Greenway projects through January 2018. The \$490,000 grant will fund Conservancy staff time, consultants and expenses to complete 6 major milestones recommended in the Strategic Action Plan (2014). Kennett Township has become newest municipality to join the Brandywine Creek Greenway. Conservancy staff will begin working with local stakeholders through the inventory and analysis process as was done with other Greenway municipalities during 2010-2013. It will take about one year to update the Concept Map and to compile the new Project Portfolio. Kennett Township is the 25th municipality in the study area.
