

## VPP Grant Awarded



East Brandywine Township was recently awarded a Vision Partnership Program Grant to prepare the East-West Bicycle and Pedestrian Facilities Plan. The goal of this project is to complete a planning study of a proposed trail that will provide safe pedestrian and bicycle connections between Hibernia County Park and the County's Struble Trail. The East-West Trail is included on East Brandywine Township's official map, and is included in West Brandywine Township's comprehensive plan (2005). The Strategic Action Plan for the Brandywine Creek Greenway recommends several trail projects that are incorporated into the East-West Trail project: EBWT 4, Dowlin Forge Road Creek Access; EBWT 9, Dowlin Forge Road Trail; EBWT 10, Whittaker Memorial Park Bridge; and WBWT 5, The Ridings Trail.
