RESOLUTION NO. 2016-17

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF HONEY BROOK TOWNSHIP, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA ACCEPTING THE DEED OF DEDICATION OF MORGANTOWN ENTERPRISES, LP OF CERTAIN PUBLIC ROADS AS PARTICULARLY BOUNDED AND DESCRIBED IN SAID DEED OF DEDICATION

WHEREAS, Morgantown Enterprises, LP, delivered to Honey Brook Township a deed of dedication dated October 16, 2015, which offers to dedicate to Honey Brook Township certain parcels of land identified as Merwood Drive, Plumwood Road, and Woodglen Road, as described in the legal descriptions attached as Exhibit "A" to the Deed of Dedication attached hereto as Exhibit 1; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Honey Brook Township at its regularly scheduled public meeting on October 14, 2015, took formal action to accept the said deed of dedication; and

WHEREAS, a resolution accepting said deed of dedication is required to be provided in filings to the Chester County Clerk of Courts to have said public roads officially added to the Chester County road docket.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of Honey Brook Township, Chester County, Pennsylvania ("Board"), as follows:

- a. The Board re-affirms its acceptance of the deed of dedication of the public roads and right-of-ways as particularly bounded and described herein.
- b. The aforesaid public roads and right-of-ways are hereby accepted as part of the system of public streets and roads of Honey Brook Township, to a width and length as described herein, to be known as:
 1. Merwood Drive;
 2. Plumwood Road; and
 3. Woodglen Road.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that if any provision, sentence, clause, section, or part of this Resolution shall for any reason be found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such determination shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections, or parts of this Resolution, and it is hereby declared to be the intent of the Board of Supervisors of Honey Brook Township that this Resolution would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid provision, sentence, clause, section or part not been included herein.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that all Resolutions or parts of Resolutions inconsistent with this Resolution are hereby superseded.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall become effective immediately.
