RESOLUTION NO. 2016-20

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF HONEY BROOK TOWNSHIP, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA ACCEPTING THE DEED OF DEDICATION OF THE RUTT FAMILY SONSHINE, L.P. N/B/N/C SONSHINE I, L.P. OF CERTAIN PUBLIC ROADS AS PARTICULARLY BOUNDED AND DESCRIBED IN SAID DEED OF DEDICATION

WHEREAS, The Ruff Family Sonshine, L.P. n/b/n/c Sonshine I, L.P., delivered to Honey Brook Township a deed of dedication dated August 18, 2016, which offers to dedicate to Honey Brook Township a certain parcel of land identified as Whitehorse Drive, as described in the Deed of Dedication attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Honey Brook Township wishes to accept the Deed of Dedication of the right-of-way for construction of a public road as described herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of Honey Brook Township, Chester County, Pennsylvania ("Board"), as follows:

- a. The Board accepts the Deed of Dedication of the right-of-way for construction of a public road known as Whitehorse Drive as particularly bounded and described therein.
- b. The aforesaid public road and right-of-way is hereby accepted as part of the system of public streets and roads of Honey Brook Township, to a width and length as described in Exhibit A hereto, to be known as Whitehorse Drive.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that if any provision, sentence, clause, section, or part of this Resolution shall for any reason be found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such determination shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections, or parts of this Resolution, and it is hereby declared to be the intent of the Board of Supervisors of Honey Brook Township that this Resolution would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid provision, sentence, clause, section or part not been included herein.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that all Resolutions or parts of Resolutions inconsistent with this Resolution are hereby superseded.


