The second year of implementation for the Greenway was a productive one! Congratulations to Greenway liaisons, municipal staff, volunteers and others on your accomplishments during 2016. We thank our municipal partners, the William Penn

Foundation, PA DCNR and Chester County for your ongoing support and enthusiasm.

- Conservancy-led plantings resulted in **1,125 trees being planted** in Kennett, East Brandywine, Pennsbury, Pocopson and East Bradford Townships.
- **328 acres preserved** in Honey Brook Township
- **22 acres preserved** in Pennsbury Township
- **18.6 miles of new trails planned** across 12 municipalities:
 - Harvey Run Trail, Chadds Ford: 0.6 miles
 - Brandywine Trail, East Bradford and Pennsbury: 0.3 miles
 - Chester Valley Trail extension, Chester County: 3 miles
 - Mill Trail, South Coatesville/Coatesville/Modena/Valley: 5.7 miles
 - East-West Trail Study, East Brandywine/West Brandywine/Uwchlan: 7 mi
 - High Trail Study, Brandywine Conservancy (in Chadds Ford): 1 mile
 - Honey Brook Trail Study, Honey Brook: 4 miles
 - Glenmoore Trail Planning, Wallace: 1 mile (estimate)
