The Riverwalk Trail Park has helped beautify and revitalize a former industrial area in the City of Coatesville, Chester County. This urban oasis is approximately 1/4 mile long and threads beneath the historic Coatesville High Bridge, a stone arch railroad viaduct that crosses the West Branch Brandywine Creek. The park was constructed between 2010 and 2012 with funding from Chester County and the Pa Department of Conservation and Natural Resources.



East-West Study Documents Online



East Brandywine Township, West Brandywine Township and Uwchlan Township have begun working on the East-West Bicycle and Pedestrian Facilities Plan with consultants McMahon Associates and Brandywine Conservancy. A community workshop was held on June 20th where residents were invited to provide comments and feedback on a range of options and approaches for a 9-mile corridor that would connect Hibernia County Park to the Struble Trail.
