



**Resolution 2017-10 By the Honey Brook Township Board of Supervisors
Relative to Commending Honey Brook Borough**

WHEREAS, in 1815, the village of Waynesburg was formed, and

WHEREAS, the Philadelphia-Downingtown-Lancaster railroad was completed in 1884, resulting in the village's name change from Waynesburg to Honey Brook, and

WHEREAS, the village of Honey Brook was incorporated into a Borough in 1891, and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council approved the formation of the Honey Brook Fire Company in 1892, and

WHEREAS, the Borough accepted public water as of September 1896, and

WHEREAS, Electric streetlights replaced gas lamps in the Borough in 1915, and

WHEREAS, the population of Honey Brook Borough increased from 700 in 1891 to 1,713 in 2010, and

WHEREAS, a Police Department comprised of one Chief and four Patrolmen keep the peace in the Borough, and

WHEREAS, a Public Works Department of three persons keeps the streets and storm sewers in working order, and

WHEREAS, a current Administrative Staff of five persons sees to the day-to-day needs of citizens of Honey Brook Borough, serves as code enforcement, and provides Emergency Management services, and

WHEREAS, a Council of seven persons serves the citizens of the Borough, and

WHEREAS, a Mayor serves the citizens of the Borough, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED by the Honey Brook Township Board of Supervisors, John McHugh, Chair, Tracy Olsen, Vice Chair, and Travis Stacey, Member, recognize and congratulate the Honey Brook Borough on the occasion of its 125th Anniversary Celebration.
