

NOTICE TO THE RESIDENTS OF HONEY BROOK TOWNSHIP

The Board of Supervisors of Honey Brook Township, Chester County, Pennsylvania, shall consider the enactment of the Ordinance summarized below on Wednesday, September 13, 2017, beginning at 7:00 PM, in the Honey Brook Township Building located 500 Suplee Road, Honey Brook, PA 19344 in Honey Brook Township. The complete title and summary of the proposed Ordinance are as follows:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HONEY BROOK AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF HONEY BROOK TOWNSHIP, TO ESTABLISH A NEW CHAPTER 8 ENTITLED “FLOODPLAIN MANAGEMENT”, REQUIRING ALL PERSONS, PARTNERSHIPS, BUSINESSES, AND CORPORATIONS TO OBTAIN A PERMIT FOR ANY CONSTRUCTION OR DEVELOPMENT; PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF SUCH PERMITS; SETTING FORTH CERTAIN MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR NEW CONSTRUCTION AND DEVELOPMENT WITHIN AREAS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HONEY BROOK WHICH ARE SUBJECT TO FLOODING; AND ESTABLISHING PENALTIES FOR ANY PERSONS WHO FAIL, OR REFUSE TO COMPLY WITH, THE REQUIREMENTS OR PROVISIONS OF SUCH CHAPTER.

Section 1 amends the Code of Ordinances of Honey Brook Township, Chapter 8, to insert regulations related to the management of floodplains within the Township, including requirements for permits for construction or development in areas which are subject to flooding, and penalties for non-compliance. Section 2 is a severability provision. Section 3 is a repealer. Section 4 provides that all existing ordinances of Honey Brook Township remain in full force and effect. Section 5 provides an effective date.

All interested persons are invited to attend and be heard. A complete copy of the proposed Ordinance is on file with this newspaper. A complete copy of the proposed Ordinance is available for inspection without charge and for copying at a charge not greater than the cost thereof at the Township Building during regular office hours.
