

NOTICE TO THE RESIDENTS OF HONEY BROOK TOWNSHIP

The Board of Supervisors of Honey Brook Township, Chester County, Pennsylvania, shall consider the enactment of the Ordinance summarized below on Wednesday, September 13, 2017, beginning at 7:00 PM, in the Honey Brook Township Building located 500 Suplee Road, Honey Brook, PA 19344 in Honey Brook Township. The complete title and summary of the proposed Ordinance are as follows:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HONEY BROOK AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF HONEY BROOK TOWNSHIP, CHAPTER 1 ENTITLED ADMINISTRATION AND GOVERNMENT”, TO ESTABLISH A PART 4 ENTITLED “INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT FOR THE UPPER WEST BRANCH BRANDYWINE CREEK WATERSHED”, AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL COST-SHARING AND COOPERATION AGREEMENT WITH HONEY BROOK BOROUGH FOR ADMINISTERING THE MS4 PERMIT REQUIREMENTS FOR THE UPPER WEST BRANCH BRANDYWINE CREEK WATERSHED.

Section 1 amends the Code of Ordinances of Honey Brook Township, Chapter 1, to add a new Part 4, approving and incorporating an intergovernmental cooperation agreement with Honey Brook Borough for MS4 compliance in the Upper West Branch Brandywine Creek Watershed. Section 2 provides that all existing ordinances of Honey Brook Township remain in full force and effect. Section 3 is a severability provision. Section 4 is a repealer. Section 5 provides an effective date.

All interested persons are invited to attend and be heard. A complete copy of the proposed Ordinance is on file with this newspaper.
