

**NOTICE TO THE RESIDENTS OF HONEY BROOK TOWNSHIP**

The Board of Supervisors of Honey Brook Township, Chester County, Pennsylvania, shall consider the enactment of the Ordinance summarized below on Wednesday, September 13, 2017, beginning at 7:00 PM, in the Honey Brook Township Building located 500 Suplee Road, Honey Brook, PA 19344 in Honey Brook Township. The complete title and summary of the proposed Ordinance are as follows:

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HONEY BROOK REGULATING PARKS, FOR ADDITION TO THE CODE OF HONEY BROOK TOWNSHIP AS A NEW CHAPTER 17 ENTITLED PARKS AND RECREATION.**

Section 1 amends the Code of Ordinances of Honey Brook Township to insert a new Chapter 17 containing rules and regulations governing activity in park and recreation land open to the public and under the jurisdiction of Honey Brook Township. Section 2 authorizes the posting of signage with such rules and regulations. Section 3 provides that all existing ordinances of Honey Brook Township remain in full force and effect. Section 4 is a severability provision. Section 5 is a repealer. Section 6 provides an effective date.

All interested persons are invited to attend and be heard. A complete copy of the proposed Ordinance is on file with this newspaper.
