

**NOTICE TO THE RESIDENTS OF HONEY BROOK TOWNSHIP**

The Board of Supervisors of Honey Brook Township, Chester County, Pennsylvania, will hold a public hearing on Wednesday, August 9, 2017 at 7:00 p.m. in the Honey Brook Township Building located at 500 Suplee Road, Honey Brook, PA 19344 in Honey Brook Township, for the purpose of considering and rendering a decision with respect to an Application for Conditional Use submitted by Reuben S. King in accordance with Chapter 27, Part 16, Section 1604.M and the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code (53 P.S. § 10101, et seq.). The property is in the Agricultural Zoning District. The Application for Conditional Use, if approved by the Board of Supervisors of Honey Brook Township, would permit Reuben S. King to use the property owned by Levi S. King and Ruth Ann King located at 295 Old Pequea Lane in Honey Brook Township as a kennel. There is a residential dwelling and other agricultural related structures existing on the property which will remain on the property.

Complete copies of the full text of the Conditional Use Application, Zoning Ordinance, and Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code are on file and may be examined without charge or obtained for a charge not greater than the cost of copying thereof at the Honey Brook Township Building during regular office hours.
