

PUBLIC NOTICE: The Honey Brook Collaborative Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) Plan And Pollution Reduction Plan (PRP) for the East and West Branches of the Brandywine Creek and their unnamed tributaries, the Christiana River Basin, and Pequea Creek/Chesapeake Bay Watershed is available for public review on the Township website at <http://honeybrooktwp.com> and by request at the Township Building at 500 Suplee Road, Honey Brook, PA 19344. This plan is a joint effort between Honey Brook Township and Honey Brook Borough. Written comments from the public will be accepted at the Township Building from August 1 through August 31, 2017. Verbal and written comments will also be accepted during the Honey Brook Township Board of Supervisors Meeting scheduled for August 9, 2017 at 7:00 pm at the Township Building. The PRP / TMDL Plan describes the existing loading of pollutants discharged from the Honey Brook Township and Honey Brook Borough MS4 to the East and West Branches of the Brandywine and their unnamed tributaries, the Christiana River Basin and Pequea Creek/Chesapeake Bay Watershed (Honey Brook Township only) and presents a plan to reduce these pollutants. The PRP / TMDL Plan is a requirement of the Township's National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) permit. The Board of Supervisors reserves the right to conduct such other business as may come before it.
