ORDINANCE # 192-2017**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HONEY BROOK AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF HONEY BROOK TOWNSHIP, CHAPTER 1 ENTITLED "ADMINISTRATION AND GOVERNMENT", PART 3 ENTITLED "BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS", SUBSECTION A ENTITLED "BOARD OF ADMINISTRATIVE APPEALS", TO REMOVE THE REQUIREMENT FOR ONE MEMBER OF SUCH BOARD TO BE A SEWAGE ENFORCEMENT OFFICER.**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors of Honey Brook Township, by Ordinance No. 92-2000, enacted on August 9, 2000, created a Board of Administrative Appeals; and

**WHEREAS**, by Ordinance No. 122-2006, enacted on December 15, 2006, the Board of Supervisors of Honey Brook Township revised the requirements of membership to require that at least one member of the Board of Administrative Appeals shall be a currently licensed SEO; and

**WHEREAS**, not all matters which come before the Board of Administrative Appeals deal with sewage planning, permitting, or enforcement; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township has experienced difficulty in finding a SEO to serve in the capacity as a member of the Board of Administrative Appeals; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township wishes to appoint Township residents to serve on the Board of Administrative Appeals, and the SEO requirement makes that goal difficult to achieve; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors of Honey Brook Township has determined that it is capable of appointing individuals to the Board of Administrative Appeals who possess the requisite skills and knowledge to perform in such capacity without requiring that one member be a SEO; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Board of Supervisors of Honey Brook Township, Chester County, Pennsylvania, pursuant to the authority conferred by the Second Class Township Code, that the following be and is hereby enacted:

**BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED** by the Board of Supervisors of Honey Brook Township, Chester County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

**SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.**

The Code of the Township of Honey Brook, Chapter 1 entitled "Administration and Government", Part 3 entitled "Boards and Commissions", Subsection A entitled "Board of Administrative Appeals", Code Section §1-305.2 is hereby amended and restated to read as follows:

2. Qualifications of Board Members. Each member shall have a general working knowledge and understanding of construction techniques, materials and design, and his qualifications

to serve shall be left to the sole, absolute and unfettered discretion of the Board of Supervisors of Honey Brook Township.

**SECTION 2. FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.** All other articles, sections, parts and provisions of the Ordinances of the Township of Honey Brook shall remain in full force and effect as previously enacted and amended.


**SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY.** If any sentence, clause, section or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts hereof. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Board of Supervisors of Honey Brook Township that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.

**SECTION 4. REPEALER.** All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances conflicting with any provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this Ordinance.


**SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Ordinance shall become effective five days after enactment as provided by law.


