RESOLUTION NO. 2017 - 15

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HONEY BROOK, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING COLLECTION OF CERTAIN MUNICIPAL REAL ESTATE TAXES BY THE CHESTER COUNTY TREASURER PURSUANT TO SECTION 5511.4D OF THE LOCAL TAX COLLECTION LAW, 72 P.S. § 5511.4D

WHEREAS, Honey Brook Township, Chester County, Pennsylvania previously entered a contract with Berkheimer Tax Administrator, Inc., for the collection of Real Estate Taxes in Honey Brook Township; and

WHEREAS, the Township hereby terminates its contract with Berkheimer Tax Administrator, Inc., effective as of December 31, 2017; and

WHEREAS, Section 5511.4d of the Local Tax Collection Law, 72 P.S. § 5511.4d, provides that in a third class county, where the county treasurer has been appointed or directed by the county commissioners to bill and collect all county and county institution district taxes within a municipality under Section 1701.1(b.2) of the County Code, 16 P.S. § 1701.1(b.2), then the governing body of such municipality may by agreement with the county commissioners provide that the county treasurer shall have the duties and responsibilities of billing and collecting taxes levied by the municipality; and

WHEREAS, the county commissioners of Chester County have appointed the County Treasurer to collect all county taxes within Honey Brook Township; and

WHEREAS, Honey Brook Township has requested that the Chester County Commissioners enter into an agreement with said Township to authorize the Chester County Treasurer's Office to collect Honey Brook Township Real Estate Taxes commencing on January 1, 2018, for a one (1) year period, with such agreement automatically renewing on a year-to-year basis unless terminated with thirty (30) days written notice by either party; and

WHEREAS, the County and Honey Brook Township have caused a written agreement which memorializes all of the terms and conditions of this service to be prepared, which agreement outlines the specific powers and scope of authority delegated to the County, and which agreement is attached to this Resolution (the "Agreement"); and

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved that the Board of Supervisors for Honey Brook Township hereby authorizes the Chester County Treasurer to commence collection of Honey Brook Township Real Estate Taxes commencing on January 1, 2018, consistent with the terms and conditions set forth herein and as set forth in the Agreement.


FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of Honey Brook Township hereby authorizes the Township Manager to execute the said Agreement with the Chester County Commissioners, and to take all actions and execute all documents necessary to further the purpose and intent of this Resolution.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that if any provision, sentence, clause, section, or part of this Resolution shall for any reason be found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such determination shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections, or parts of this Resolution, and it is hereby declared to be the intent of the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Honey Brook that this Resolution would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid provision, sentence, clause, section or part not be included herein.


FURTHER RESOLVED, that all Resolutions or parts of Resolutions inconsistent with this Resolution are hereby superseded.



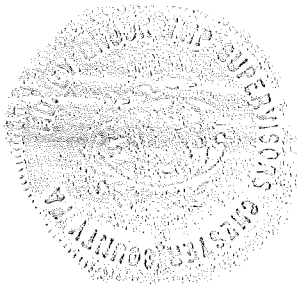
