**RESOLUTION DESIGNATING EMERGENCY SERVICE PROVIDERS
FOR HONEY BROOK TOWNSHIP**

WHEREAS, THE Board of Supervisors of Honey Brook Township is responsible under the Second Class Township Code for the public safety of the residents of Honey Brook Township.

WHEREAS, THE Board of Commissioners of the County of Chester has requested that Honey Brook Township provide the Board of Commissioners with a resolution outlining the methods and agencies chosen to fulfill the public safety needs of Honey Brook Township for the efficient administration of the emergency communications system of the Chester County Department of Emergency Services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Honey Brook Fire Company, Chester County will provide fire and rescue protection; and,

FURTHER, BE IT RESOLVED the Elverson-Honey Brook EMS will provide ambulance service; and,

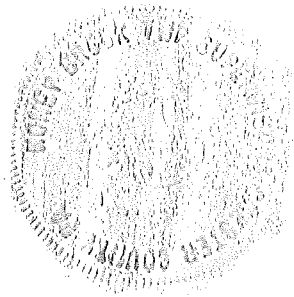
FURTHER, BE IT RESOLVED the Pennsylvania State Police of Embreeville will provide police protection; and,

FURTHER, BE IT RESOLVED the Honey Brook Fire Company will provide Fire Police services; and,

FURTHER, BE IT RESOLVED that Medic 93 of the Brandywine Hospital will provide Advanced Life Support Services; and,

FURTHER, BE IT RESOLVED, the contact persons between said organizations and the Chester County Department of Emergency Services shall be the Robert Esposito, Jr., Honey Brook Township Emergency Management Coordinator and Steven Landes, Honey Brook Township Manager.
