Write your own plan!

To be in compliance with Pennsylvania law, most farms are required to have either a conservation plan or agricultural erosion and sediment control plans. Often, these plans can be expensive. To help solve this problem, the Chester County Conservation District, in conjunction with Penn State University, is offering a conservation plan writing workshop that will allow farmers to write their own plans – for **FREE!** Farmers will need to attend both days of a two-part workshop on March 13, 2018 and March 21, 2018. Bob Neiderer, from Penn State, will walk farmers through the Pennsylvania One Stop program, which allows farmers to write their own plans that meet Pennsylvania law.
