Become a Certified Adult Mental Health First Aider

Adult Mental Health First Aid is a free public education program designed to teach citizens the skills to help another person who is struggling with a mental health concern or crisis. Program participants will:

- Learn risk factors, warning signs and the impact of mental health concerns
- Practice the Mental Health First Aid action plan
- Learn local resources for mental health and substance abuse treatment
- Receive a comprehensive, user-friendly manual and certification

Participants are required to attend the eight hours of training from one of the available sessions to receive certification:
