Honey Brook Community Partnership Grant Overview

Purpose:

To help fulfill the partnership's mission statement by awarding funds to organizations who are impacting the Honey Brook Community in a positive way.

Procedure:

- Annual grants will be awarded to not-for-profit organizations serving the Honey Brook Borough and Township community, or as approved by the committee.
- A Honey Brook Partnership Grant Request Application must be submitted.

 - Applications may be emailed to Dawn or mailed to HBCP PO box 344 Honey Brook, Pa 19344
- Each grant applicant must make a 5 minute presentation to the steering committee, at a partnership meeting to explain how the funds will benefit the community. This will provide an opportunity for the steering committee to learn about the organization and to ask questions.
 - Partnership meetings are held the second Tuesday of the month at Heatherwood Retirement Community.
 - 2018 Steering committee meeting dates for presentations are:
 - March 13
 - April 10
 - Presentation times slots available are between 8-8:30 a.m.
 - Applicants will be notified of presentation date and time by phone or email.
- The number and dollar amount of grants available may vary each year. In general, the minimum grant awarded will be \$250. The maximum amount awarded to any one organization could be \$1,000.
- The person submitting the request will be notified if the grant has been awarded soon after the in April. Checks will be presented at the partnership's Spring Social on April 26, 2018.
