RESOLUTION NO. 2018 - 11

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF HONEY BROOK TOWNSHIP, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF ASPHALT PRODUCTS THROUGH A STATE CONTRACT

WHEREAS, Honey Brook Township is a Second Class Township in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, as a Second Class Township, Honey Brook Township is governed by the Pennsylvania Second Class Township Code; and

WHEREAS, Section 1502 of the Second Class Township Code, 53 P.S. § 66502, provides for purchases deemed to be in the best interest of the Township by the Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, purchases through a PennDOT Contract that allows municipalities to piggyback also satisfies the requirements for bids for purchases of materials and supplies provided for in Article XXXI of the Second Class Township Code, 53 P.S. §68101 - §68109; and

WHEREAS, the Township has identified the need to purchase various asphalt products for the Public Works Department; and

WHEREAS, Highway Materials, Inc. can provide Asphalt under a PennDOT contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Honey Brook Township that the Township Manager and the Director of Public Works are authorized to purchase various Asphalt Products from Highway Materials, Inc. from their PennDOT contract according to the attached price lists; and



FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall become effective immediately or as soon as legally permissible.




